- Recent Club Happenings -

<u>Dive report – Paul Pacey Shiprock shore dive June 23 2012. The Leap shore dive June 24 2012.</u>

After weeks of poor weather and even poorer vis we finally lucked in for the weekend of 23rd and 24th

June.



On Saturday we had an impromptu shore dive at Shiprock on a glorious sunny day.

A few of us started the activities an hour before the dive by having breakfast down by the water at Shiprock. This is alongside the new entry point and is now known as "Shiprock Patio".

The water was surprisingly warm (maybe 17C?) and vis was OK at 5 to 8 metres in patches. A new member James Nassou joined us for this dive. I was hoping to show James one of the two Mosaic Moray eels which we found when we dived here on the Wednesday before but no such luck on the day.



Lucky for us Rob Trudgeon had his camera on the Wednesday to capture the evidence. At one stage Gary Perkins swam past on his way back to the exit and showed on his slate that they had found a Black Anglerfish and indicated that it was up ahead of us somewhere (Nancy was the one who originally found it).

On the way back to the exit James and I also spotted a large Estuary Cod lurking in a crevice.

I'm not exactly sure how many club members dived but someone counted 18 club members at the D'Lish Café after the dive – I wish I had shares in that place!


On the Sunday we had a Leap Dive on the program and the weather again was very nice to us. The sea conditions were perfect at The Leap. Some club members turned up early so we had an early and a late shift. We had 9 divers on the late shift, including another new member, Nick. We asked Kelly to find us a nice seahorse – so she did. It was about 20mm long and looked like a piece of fine purple thread. It took 30 seconds for my crummy eyes to work out what it was. Eddie didn't even bother trying to get his camera to focus on it. Kelly looked very pleased with herself! Michael soon found a larger seahorse for Eddie's camera. The current was just urging us along at a comfortable rate, the vis was excellent (15m) and the water was warm(ish) – a very pleasant way to spend an hour (and a bit – some people hit deco so it must have been enjoyable). It wasn't very fishy but a few people commented on the frequent schools of large silver bream cruising along the sand line.

Coffee and Cake after – of course!
